
Arizona Rail Facts

- Going the distance. In Arizona alone, 12 freight railroads operate across 1,820 miles of track.
- Supporting jobs. As of 2017, Arizona freight railroads and their suppliers employed 5,232 people; nationwide, freight rail supported about 1.1 million jobs.
- Connecting markets. The most common commodities originating from Arizona markets are, in carloads/year: intermodal (53,400), nonmetallic minerals (4,700), petroleum (4,300), glass and stone (3,900), and primary metal products (3,800).
- Powering state economies. Spending by Class I railroads in 2017 generated nearly \$220 billion in U.S. economic activity and \$26 billion in state and federal tax revenues, according to a Towson University study.
- Preserving infrastructure, cutting congestion. Freight railroads take 7.2 million truckloads off Arizona roads annually.
- Reducing pollution. Moving freight by rail instead of trucks reduces greenhouse gas emissions by an average of 75 percent.
