

Virginia Rail Facts

- **Going the distance.** In Virginia alone, 10 freight railroads operate across 3,141 miles of track.
- **Supporting jobs.** As of 2017, Virginia freight railroads and their suppliers employed 8,708 people; nationwide, freight rail supported about 1.1 million jobs.
- **Connecting markets.** The most common commodities originating from Virginia markets are, in carloads/year: intermodal (289,400), coal (118,500), stone, sand & gravel (59,100), chemicals (10,100), and glass and stone (9,000).
- **Powering state economies.** Spending by Class I railroads in 2017 generated nearly \$220 billion in U.S. economic activity and \$26 billion in state and federal tax revenues, according to a Towson University study.
- **Preserving infrastructure, cutting congestion.** Freight railroads take 7.1 million truckloads off Virginia roads annually.
- **Reducing pollution.** Moving freight by rail instead of trucks reduces greenhouse gas emissions by an average of 75 percent.
