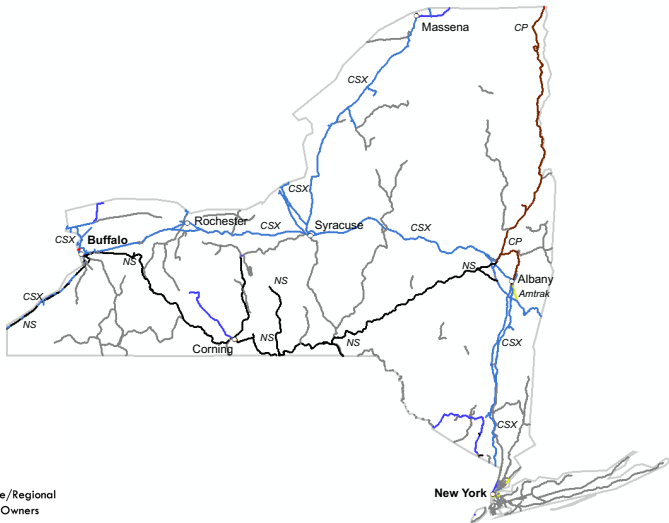


New York Rail Facts

- **Going the distance.** In New York alone, **37** freight railroads operate across **3,279 miles** of track.
- **Supporting jobs.** As of 2017, New York freight railroads and their suppliers employed **8,006 people**; nationwide, freight rail supported about **1.1 million jobs**.
- **Connecting markets.** The most common commodities originating from New York markets are, in carloads/year: **intermodal** (125,600), **waste and scrap** (21,600), chemicals (13,400), **nonmetallic minerals** (8,600), and **farm products** (3,200).
- **Powering state economies.** Spending by Class I railroads in 2017 generated nearly **\$220 billion** in U.S. economic activity and **\$26 billion** in state and federal tax revenues, according to a Towson University study.
- **Preserving infrastructure, cutting congestion.** Freight railroads take **3.6 million truckloads** off New York roads annually.
- **Reducing pollution.** Moving freight by rail instead of trucks reduces greenhouse gas emissions by an average of **75 percent**.
