These investments reduce highway congestion and emissions, relieve taxpayer burden, and make U.S. industry more competitive.

GoRail's mission is to make sure the voices of state and local leaders and citizens are heard in the national conversation about freight rail policy. Whether it's securing federal support for rail grants, supporting innovation, opposing overregulation, or promoting modal equity, GoRail helps ensure that freight rail can continue delivering public benefits without relying on taxpayer dollars.

Connecting Every Mile

600+ freight railroads operate across 135,000 miles of track in 49 states. Trains move 40% of long-distance freight, from raw materials to finished goods.



Powered by People

Railroads directly employ 153,000 workers (with wages well above the national average) and support 749,000 jobs nationwide.



Driving Growth Forward

Every \$1 spent by railroads creates \$2.50 in economic activity across America.



Greener by Design

Rail is the most fuel-efficient way to move freight over land—generating up to 75% fewer emissions than trucks.

The U.S. freight rail network is considered the world's safest, most cost-efficient, and most productive.
