Iowa Rail Facts

- Going the distance. In lowa alone, 16 freight railroads operate across 3,834 miles of track.
- Supporting jobs. As of 2017, lowa freight railroads and their suppliers employed 3.181 people; nationwide, freight rail supported about 1.1 million jobs.
- Connecting markets. The most common commodities originating from lowa markets are, in carloads/year: food products (199,000), chemicals (146,000), and farm products (83,500).
- Powering state economies. Spending by Class I railroads in 2017 generated nearly \$220 billion in U.S. economic activity and \$26 billion in state and federal tax revenues. according to a Towson University study.
- Preserving infrastructure, cutting congestion. Freight railroads take 17.4 million truckloads off lowa roads annually.
- Reducing pollution. Moving freight by rail instead of trucks reduces greenhouse gas emissions by an average of 75 percent.
