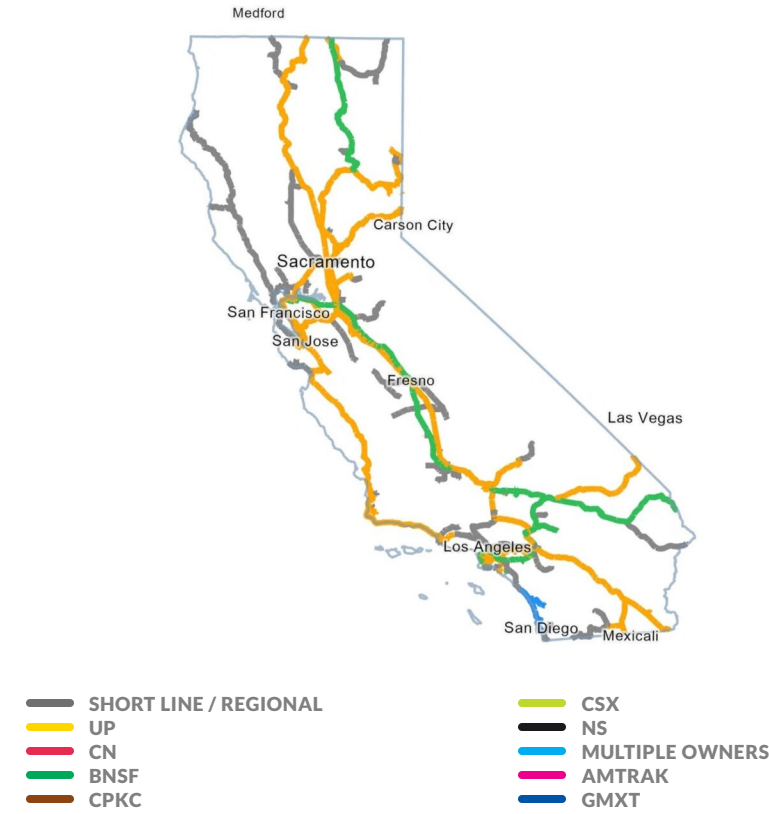

Supports Manufacturing

Strengthens Agriculture
