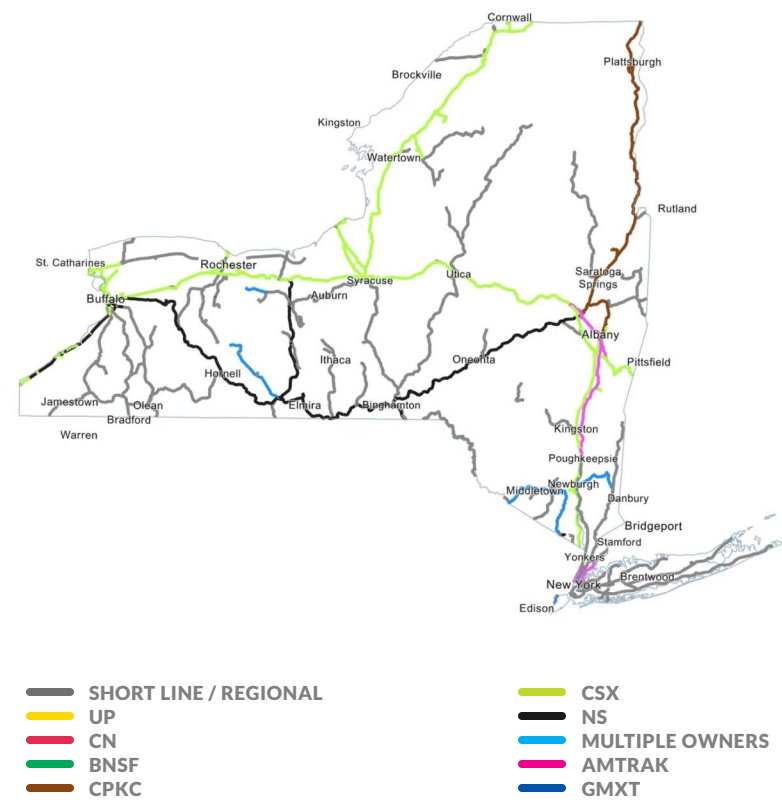

Supports Manufacturing
